o Lead the evolution and deepening of the FRB's strategic partnership with Collège Sainte-Anne (CSA), leveraging synergies and collaborative opportunities to further the Foundation's objectives.

 - Development and promotion of the digital twin of the Bouchard Creek watershed
 - Oversight of the creation and public display of a detailed 2m x 2m 3D model of the watershed.

Scalability and Reusability Assurance:

 Ensure all FRB artifacts, methodologies, and projects demonstrate clear scalability and reusability, initially focusing on other waterways on the Island of Montreal, with future applicability beyond the region.

Special Conditions of the Mandate

 Act as the primary driving force behind both strategic and operational levels of the FRB, committing significant leadership and oversight while ensuring the sustainable growth of the Foundation.

Expected Deliverables

- Recruitment and retention of committed, strategically aligned private-sector board members.
- Consistent securing of significant recurring donations through compelling strategic communications and outreach.
- Strengthened and strategically beneficial partnership with Collège Sainte-Anne.
- Successful delivery and continuous promotion of flagship FRB initiatives (digital twin, 3D model, and clean-up tools/processes).
- Demonstrable scalability and reusability of FRB-developed methodologies and artifacts.

Duration of the Mandate

This mandate will continue for the next twelve months, beginning in June 2025, and will be reviewed annually to ensure continuous alignment with the strategic evolution of the FRB.

Validation and Monitoring

Quarterly strategic reviews will be conducted with the FRB Board of Directors to evaluate progress, monitor alignment with strategic objectives, and ensure adaptability to emerging opportunities and challenges.
